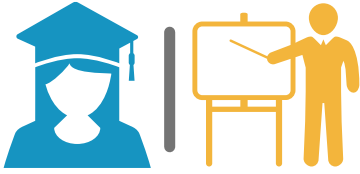
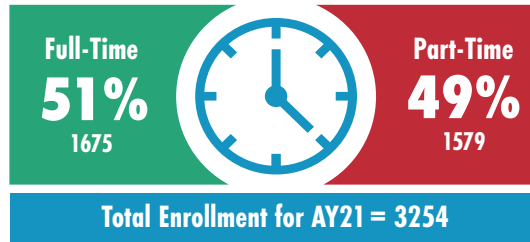

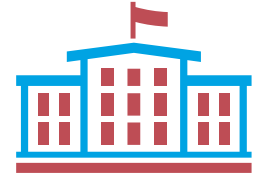

### Enrollment By Attendance<sup>3</sup>



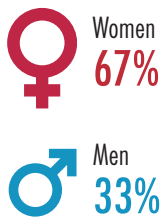

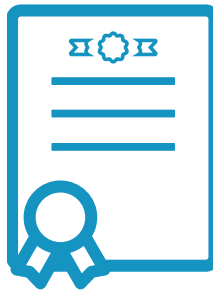
